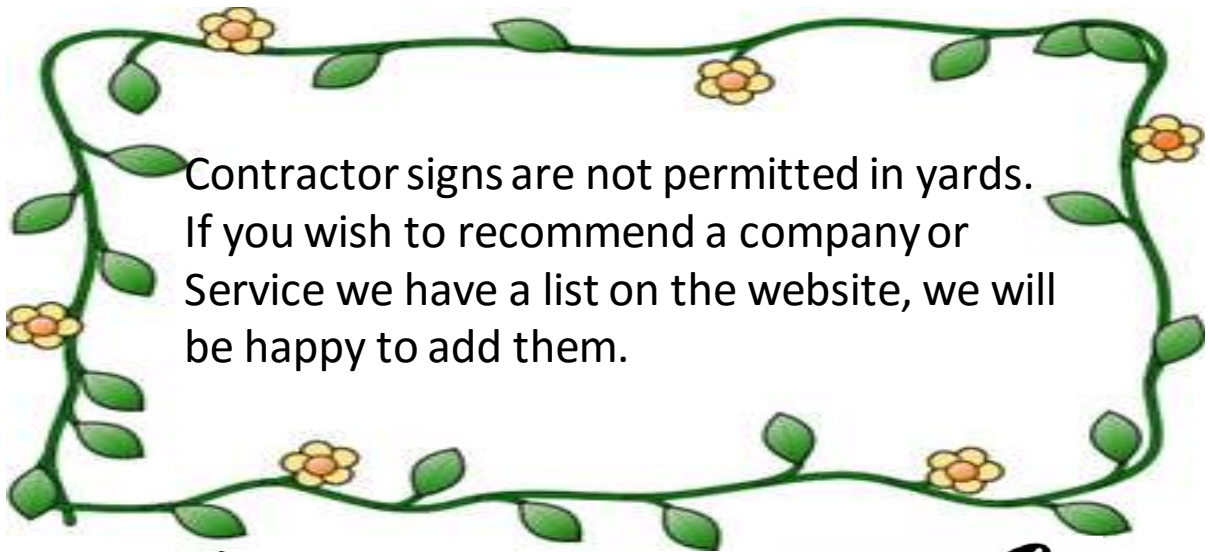
We discussed the annual picnic and wanted to see if there is any interest in bringing it back. Drop me an e-mail if you would like to see it come back.
